

St Michael's is now open for a service with Holy Communion at 10.15 on Sundays

Everyone who wishes to come to this service is welcome. You can enter on your own or with members of your immediate household. Numbers will be limited to allow for social distancing and necessary hygiene measures. Please be patient if this means you have to wait.

This service will be a little different to a normal service as there will be no hymns and communion (bread only) will be brought to you in your pew.

We confirm we have read and complied with the government's guidance on managing the risk of COVID-19 in places of worship.

What we have done:

- We have carried out a COVID-19 risk assessment
- We have cleaning, hand cleansing and hygiene procedures in place, in line with government guidance
- We have taken all reasonable steps to help everyone maintain a 2m distance between different users of our church.

What we expect you to do:

- Do not enter if you are feeling unwell or have experienced any COVID-19 symptoms in the past seven days.
- Take responsibility for your own safety and that of your household and other people by maintaining social distancing and observing all hygiene measures.
- Wait for guidance from the wardens and follow their instructions.
- Sanitise your hands on entering and leaving the church.
- Wear a mask (unless you have a medical condition which makes this difficult)
- Wait for a warden to show you to your seat.
- Remain seated throughout the service.
- Ensure children are supervised at all times
- Leave the church as directed at the end of the service.
